

4 Easy Steps to Enroll in GED® Preparatory Classes at Withlacoochee Technical College

If you are 16 or 17 contact your zoned school to get permission to enter the program **PRIOR** to following the steps below.

Step 1: Complete an Application

- Complete an application and provide a copy of a government issued photo identification.
- A \$30.00 non-refundable application fee must be paid to the Business Office upon acceptance of your application. Financial aid may be available to qualified students. Applications are available in Student Services.
- Contact Student Services to schedule an appointment to meet with a counselor/ career advisor

Step 2: Placement Testing

- Call Student Services department at 352-726-2430 ext. 4326 to schedule an appointment to take the TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education). TABE is offered every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Testing may begin anytime between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (except Holidays).
- Bring valid government issued photo identification with you to the TABE.
- Note: TABE scores are not a predictor of success on the GED test®. TABE scores are used for placement only.

Step 3: Meet with a Counselor

- All students must meet in-person with a counselor/advisor. Your TABE scores will be reviewed and discussed at this meeting as well as class times.

Step 4: Payment of Fees

- Fees are \$30 per term.
- Activity fee is \$15 per term.
- Tuition and fees are due in full prior to attending class.
- Tuition is non-refundable once a student begins class.
