Likewise, High-Liability Specialized Instructor Courses provide the required training to apply for a High-Liability Instructor Certification in a particular area of specialization (Rule 11B-20.0014, F.A.C.).

Students enrolled in a Specialized Instructor Course must achieve a passing score of at least 85% on the written end-of-course exam on the first attempt and demonstrate the required skills (Rule 11B-35.0024, F.A.C.).
