Prerequisites:

Students must have a vehicle mounted stationary-moving radar and a handheld laser for this class.

Students must possess at least three years' experience as a speed measurement device operator and must have successfully completed one of the following courses or combination of courses:

- Advanced Course 1158, Speed Measurement Course

OR

- Advanced Course 055, Radar Speed Measurement Training Course for Law Enforcement Officers (retired 12/31/06) and Advanced Course 095, Laser Speed Measurement Operators Course for Law Enforcement Officers (retired 12/31/06)

OR

- Advanced Course 055, Radar Speed Measurement Training Course for Law Enforcement Officers (retired 12/31/06) and Specialized Course 1113, Laser Speed Measurement Device (LSMD) Transition Operators Course.

This is a Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Trust-Funded Course for Region 6. Officers in Region 6 attend free of charge. In order to attend, all officers are required to process the appropriate paperwork through their respective agencies. Courses in the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Specialized Training Program are designed for post-basic or in-service training to enhance an officer's knowledge, skills, and abilities in a specific area, pursuant to Rule 11B-35.007, Florida Administrative Code. This specialized instructor course provides the required training an officer must have to apply for an Instructor Certification in Speed Measurement.
