### Career and Technical Program - Scholarship and Financial Aid Resources

#### Scholarships:

The following are just some of the scholarships that are available to students. Please check with Student Services for more information.

Applications are in the scholarship filing cabinet within the Withlacoochee Technical College (WTC) Student Services office. Applications are to be submitted to WTC Student Services unless application says to apply directly to the scholarship organization.

Title	Deadline	Criteria
WTC Career and Technical Education Scholarship	5 weeks (25 business days) prior to each session	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have fewer than 10% absences</li> <li>• Meeting pace of progression</li> <li>• May only be used for tuition and fees</li> </ul>
Industry Certification Scholarship	Ongoing. Allow at least 5 days for committee to review. Will take additional processing time if scholarship is approved.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have met TABE requirement</li> <li>• Must have fewer than 10% absences</li> <li>• Meeting pace of progression</li> <li>• Covers exam fee only</li> <li>• Not to be completed until instructor indicates student is ready for the exam</li> </ul>
Rotary Upward Bound	Ongoing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have received Citrus County Rotary Upward Bound award while in grades K through 12.</li> </ul>

#### Other Scholarship Sources:

#### Federal Financial Aid:

The primary source of financial aid for our students is the Pell grant. To apply for the Pell grant, complete the application online at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov). Enter WTC's School Code 016258. Contact our Financial Aid office at (352) 726-2430 ext. 4316 or ext. 4332 within three to five days after completing the online application.

*Completing the online application may be necessary for other aid programs beyond the Pell Grant.*

#### Other Sources of Financial Assistance:
